- The question was asked why does the victim of a theft have to buy back their own property from a pawn shop.
 - o This is due to the pawn shop act, and the law statute 4727.12.
 - The shops are to hold the items for a time and restore them to the owners; the fee is for them holding it. You can pay for the item so you do not have to go to court and hope the store holds onto the item for the length for the proceedings.

The pawn shops do work with the police department and the information that they provide do lead to convictions.
- Thomas Coolie was indicted in the 265 Park break in. He was also linked to one on Elliot in August and is being held in jail.
- Mosses Kuhbander was extradited to Kentucky where he is facing sexual assault charges.
